





Engagement

- 899 registrations. Some of these registrations are for couples, and for small groups. Therefore, total engagement is well over 1000 participants.
- 45 group registrations representing in many cases - whole community engagement, enabling larger groups to gather.
- 652 Female; 247 Male
- 56 Ordained, 843 lay (including religious). Note that this is based on those who identified as being ordained.
- 31 Dioceses, and some other organisations at regional, state or national level.


