
It's just plain wrong that the Catholic Church is in decline precisely when the world needs it most.

THREE KEYS TO PARISH RENEWAL

Although each parish is unique, we have seen these three keys unleash radical change in hundreds of parishes around the world.

The Power of the Holy Spirit

Prayer is the engine of our mission. This is God's work. You are not enough, but He is. It is not by your own power that your parish will transform. Like the first disciples, you cannot set off on your own as the hero of the story. First, you pray. Then you wait until are clothed with power from on high. It is the power of the Holy Spirit that makes your work fruitful. Call on the Holy Spirit and expect him to show up, because the Father has promised him to us (Luke 24:49).

The Primacy of Evangelization

The Church exists to evangelize. Your parish exists to evangelize. In order for parishes to thrive, they must be focused on the evangelizing mission of the parish and that this evangelizing mission must be the measuring stick by which parish activities and decisions must be judged.

The Best of Leadership

If it's important for a company that sells sneakers to have the best of leadership, how much more important is it for priests — who shepherd people to God and deal with questions of the eternal? In order for parishes to thrive, they must be built on a foundation of the best leadership principles. This includes forming and leading a great team, having a strong apprenticeship culture, and a focus on servant leadership.
